## ORDER OF TEMPORARY HIGHWAY CLOSING

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Weathersfield has received funding from the U.S. Department of Transportation, Vermont Agency of Transportation, and Vermont Division of Historic Preservation to restore the Upper Falls Covered Bridge, identified as Weathersfield Bridge No. 66; and

**WHEREAS**, the restoration will cause the Bridge to become impassable to both vehicular and pedestrian traffic; and

**WHEREAS**, the safety of the public and the contractors restoring the Bridge requires that the Bridge be closed to all traffic;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Select Board for the Town of Weathersfield hereby orders that the Upper Falls Road, Town Highway 20, be closed from the intersection with Vermont Route 131 to the intersection with the Upper Falls Road Extension, Town Highway 19, for the period from June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007, through November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007, to allow the completion of the restoration project.
