REPEAL OF SEWAGE ORDINANCE
RELATING TO INDIVIDUAL SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS

Repeal of the Ordinance of the Town of Weathersfield relating to individual sewage disposal systems:

I. AUTHORITY

This repeal is enacted subject to the requirements of Title 10, Section 1976 (b), of the Vermont Statutes Annotated, which states:

As of July 1, 2007, those provisions of municipal ordinances and zoning bylaws that regulate potable water supplies and wastewater systems are superseded by the provisions of this chapter and the rules adopted under this chapter.

II. ORDINANCES REPEALED

Any provision of the Sewage Ordinance Relating to Individual Sewage Disposal Systems, adopted in 1997, or any of its predecessors in effect at the time of the repeal of this Ordinance is hereby revoked.

III. EFFECT

No section of this Ordinance shall be construed to supersede or replace any Vermont statute.

This Ordinance shall be entered in the minutes of the Select Board's meeting, and posted in at least five (5) conspicuous places within the Town of Weathersfield and published in a newspaper circulating in the Town on a day not more than fourteen (14) days following the date when the Ordinance is repealed.

This repeal will become effective on the twentieth day of August, 2007, sixty (60) days after the date of its adoption by the Select Board, unless a petition is filed with the Town Clerk by the fourth day of August, 2007, forty-four (44) days after the date of its adoption. The petition should be addressed to the Select Board, should be signed by at least five percent (5%) of the qualified voters of this municipality, and should ask for a special meeting to be called on the question of disapproving the repeal.
