

# Town of Weathersfield

## **RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Weathersfield collects property taxes on a yearly basis; and

**WHEREAS**, periodically some taxpayers become delinquent in minor amounts, totaling not more than Five Dollars (\$5.00) including penalties and interest; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost to the Town for collecting delinquent tax amounts of Five Dollars (\$5.00), or less, greatly exceeds the income received by the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, periodically some taxpayers make overpayments in minor amounts, totaling not more than Five Dollars (\$5.00); and

**WHEREAS**, the cost to the Town for reimbursement of overpayments of Five Dollars (\$5.00), or less, greatly exceeds the benefits to the Town's taxpayers as a whole,

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved that the Board of Selectmen adopt the following policy:

1. At the close of each tax year, the Delinquent Tax Collector for the Town of Weathersfield will present to the Board of Abatement a request to abate any delinquent property taxes totaling Five Dollars (\$5.00), or less; and
2. Prior to the close of each fiscal year, and after the closure of the tax year, the Town Manager shall direct that a warrant for rebate checks for tax overpayments totaling more than Five Dollars (\$5.00) be presented to the Select Board for payment authorization
